WHITE IPA – 5.6% ABV – 50 IBU's

Our take on the White IPA is a hoppy Belgian Wit beer with Orange Zest and Coriander. Unfiltered, this beer pours pale white, with a solid head. Citrus notes abound with a clean bitterness and a citrus, slightly tart finish



Marshall, MN

MOO JOOS – 5.8% ABV – 24 IBU's

Moo Joos combines the full body of a Milk Stout with the silky smoothness of an Oatmeal Stout. Lactose sugar in the boil contributes a full and creamy mouthfeel while toasted and flaked oats in the mash round out the beer with an oily texture. A deep malt bill builds layers of roasty notes with hints of chocolate, coffee and anise. A traditional British Cask Yeast is then pitched, which leaves us with a fruity, malty ale.

OLD 56 LIGHT BEER - 4.2% ABV

An American Light Lager? That's not craft beer! Eh, we still like to drink it. Named after the fire truck the city of Lucan bought in 1956, this crisp light lager is for hot days, cold days, and every day in between.



Fargo, ND

FARGO STONE'S THROW - 4.5% ABV – 19 IBU's

Patterned after the rich, smooth, malty ales of Scotland, Stone's Throw is dominated by caramel

toffee, toasty malt, hints of cocoa, residual honey sweetness and just enough hops to keep this rock on the button. The perfect brew for someone new to craft beer. Cheers, skip!



Minneapolis, MN

INDEED DAY TRIPPER PALE ALE – 5.4% ABV – 45 IBU’s

Hatched from our craving for endless adventure, big and small, far and near; Day Tripper Pale Ale is your faithful hoppy companion. Take it with you to your favorite lake, trail, or just the backyard, and you’ll be on your way. Four pounds of hops per barrel give this West Coast inspired pale ale a heady, dank, and citrus laced aroma all supported by a malt backbone complex enough to keep this from being a one-hop trick pony.

INDEED SHENANIGANS SUMMER ALE - 5.0% ABV – 14 IBU’s

A warm day, great friends and a good beer—it doesn’t get any better. In that spirit we present Shenanigans Summer Ale, our ode to the season. Brewed with Sorachi Ace hops, regionally produced honey and locally malted red wheat, Shenanigans Summer Ale has a zesty, citrus aroma, refreshingly dry body and notes of honey. So on those long hot days, remember that summer is time for Shenanigans.



Stillwater, MN

LIFT BRIDGE FARM GIRL SAISON – 5.8% ABV – 19 IBU’s

Perfectly balanced and moderately sweet with light citrus notes and a distinct spiciness from choice Belgian yeasts, Farm Girl is a refreshing beer with universal appeal. Enjoy it after a long day on the farm, or anytime the mood strikes you– whether you’re on the water, in the sun or hiding from the winter’s chill. Pairs well with most foods, including spicy dishes and Thai.



River Falls, WI

RUSH RIVER BUBBLEJACK IPA – 6.5% ABV – 60 IBU’s

Incredibly smooth, this ale is truly a phenomenon in taste. This American Style IPA is brewed with a lighter grain bill which allows the various Yakima Valley hops to shine. Bubblejack IPA is also dry-hopped prior to packaging for an added hop aroma.



Minneapolis, MN

SURLY BENDER – 5.1% ABV – 45 IBU's

This brown ale begins crisp and lightly hoppy, complemented by the velvety sleekness oats deliver. Belgian and British malts usher in cascades of cocoa, bitter-coffee, caramel, and hints of vanilla and cream.

SURLY OVERRATED - 7.3% ABV – 69 IBU's

Pale gold American (West Coast) IPA with fruity-citrus aromas from generous dry hopping.
